How we use cookies

This website uses standard technology called 'cookies'. A cookie is a small piece of information stored by your browser on your computer's hard drive. Cookies enable us to identify you and are used to simplify the logging on process for registered users. They do lots of different jobs, like letting you navigate between pages efficiently, remembering your preferences, and generally improve the user experience.

We may obtain information about your general internet usage by using a cookie file which is stored on the hard drive of your computer. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. They help us to improve StaffBank and to deliver a better and more personalised service by enabling us to store information about your preferences, and so allow us to customise StaffBank according to your individual interests, speed up your searches and recognise you when you return to StaffBank.
